Somerset Council B3139 Market Street and Market Terrace, Highbridge in the Parish of Highbridge and Burnham-On-Sea (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2023

The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

Schedule 1 Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

B3139 Market Street, Highbridge

From the junction with Market Street Roundabout in an easterly direction to its junction with Bank Street.

Schedule 2 Temporary Banned Right Turn

Market Terrace, Highbridge

From Market Terrace on to the B3139 Market Street.

Schedule 3 Temporary Banned Left Turn

B3139 Market Street, Highbridge

From the B3139 Market Street on to Market Terrace.

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
